MSFA and MBA students may choose to participate in the Summer Business in Europe Program which is held in Marseille, France in mid-June through early July (3 weeks). The program offers the opportunity to earn 9-12 credits offered in English. You can apply your financial aid to this program and you can earn credit for Actg 552 and elective credits as well. ***Part-time students may choose to take this Winter elective while in France through the Marseilles program and be finished by Winter. Assumes that the student completes the BA506 in Winter and takes BA531 and Mgmt 562 in either the first Fall or the second Fall.

****Mgmt 562 is offered in the daytime in the fall and in the evening in the spring. You do not need to take it twice, but can choose either term.

Note: Students who wish to participate in the 573/574 portfolio management course *and* the Marseilles program will need to take Fin573 in the first Winter, Fin574 in Spring immediately following, and push Mgmt 562 to the next Fall.
